Pastor's Message

In September 2019, Pope Francis instituted the Celebration of the Word of God Sunday with his TL Apostolic letter Aperuit Illis. Often celebrated on the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Australian Church this year has moved the commemoration of Word of God Sunday to the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

In his Apostolic letter, Pope Francis said:

"The relationship between the Risen Lord, the community of believers and sacred Scripture is The sesential to our identity as Christians. Without the Lord who opens our minds to them, it is impossible to Frunderstand the Scriptures in depth. Yet the contrary is equally true: without the Scriptures, the events of the mission of Jesus and of his Church in this world would remain incomprehensible. Hence, Saint Jerome could rightly claim: "Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ" (Commentary on the Book of Isaiah, Prologue: PL 24,17B)."

The Pope also said:

'The sweetness of God's word leads us to share it with all those whom we encounter in this life and to proclaim the sure hope that it contains. Its bitterness, in turn, often comes from our realisation of how difficult it is to live that word consistently, or our personal experience of seeing it rejected as meaningless for life. We should never take God's word for granted, but instead let ourselves be nourished by it, in order to acknowledge and live fully our relationship with him and with our brothers and sisters.' **God Bless, Fr Mark Franklin, Parish Priest**
